



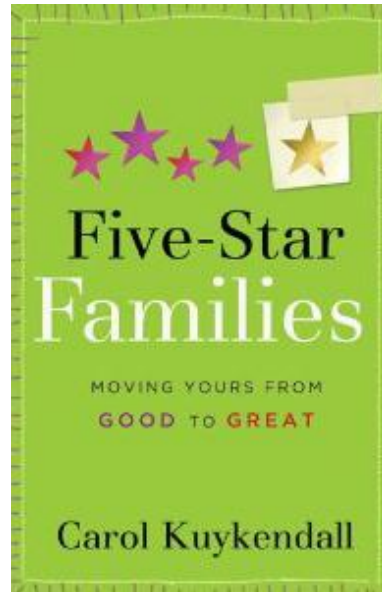
“Five-Star Families - Part 2”

James wants Christians to be patient with each other, to be straightforward in their promises, to pray for each other and to help each other remain faithful to God.

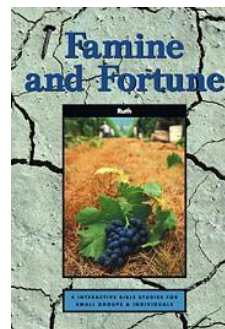
As we study this book may we be willing to obey God's leading and show our faith in action.
