QUARTERLY AND ANNUAL CHURCH MEETINGS

Do Not Forget, this Wednesday 26 August at 7.30 pm is the AGM and quarterly meeting of our Church.

The election of four Deacons will take place at the Annual meeting for a two year period & there are still two vacancies in the other group of five Deacons who come up for election next year. Contributions can be made by direct debit or Sunday envelopes; both must be marked clearly "Congo Refugees".
