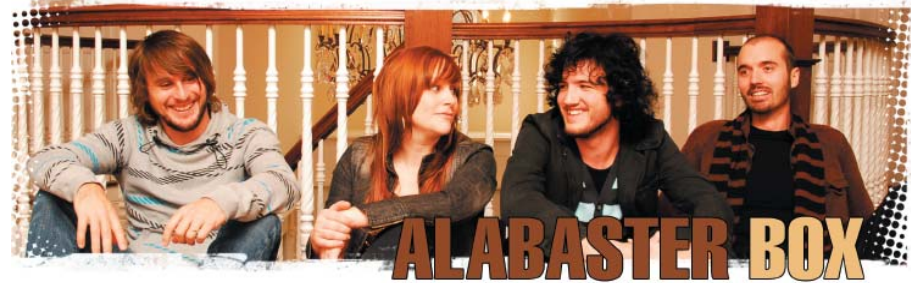
WALK TO WATER
