PASTORAL SEARCH

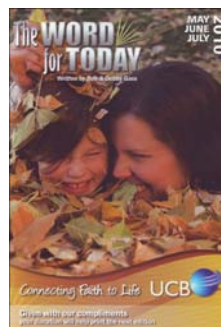
