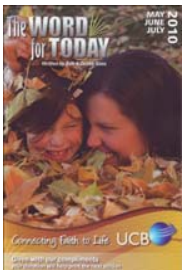

THE LIGHT NEEDS YOUR FEEDBACK

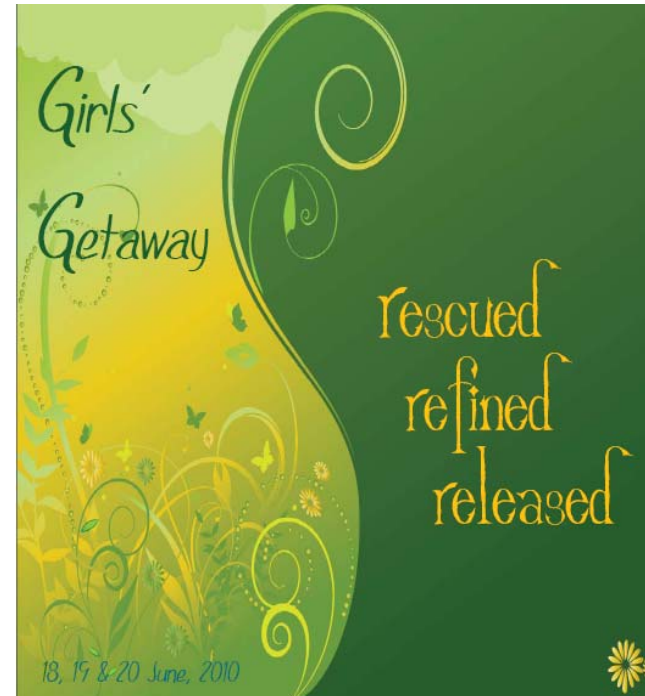
