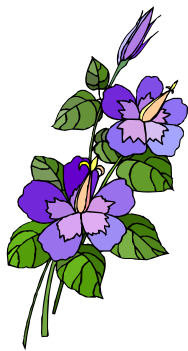

You don't need to be a young adult yourself!! All you need is a growing love for God, love for people and love for God's Word!

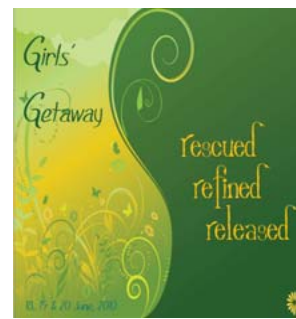
We are very thankful to *Robert Uebergang* for his willingness to take on the leadership of a *new young adult guys' small group*.
